

Fly Confirmed for Less (FCFL) Guest Passes

Program and FAQs

Program

The **Fly Confirmed for Less (FCFL)** guest passes program allows employees to book discounted confirmed travel for guests. Pass riders who are already listed on your PPR can use FCFL guest passes on their own, while any guest not listed on your PPR must be accompanied by a designated PPR pass rider.

All Endeavor employees and retirees will receive **four FCFL guest passes** each year on their hire anniversary date. The first batch was issued on Jan. 30, 2026.

On your next hire anniversary date, the passes expire and four new passes will be added to your account. Unused guest passes do not roll over.

Each guest pass is good for one-way or round-trip travel, however using a pass one-way uses up a whole pass.

FAQs

1. Who is eligible for a Fly Confirmed for Less (FCFL) guest pass?

- Any PPR pass rider may use a guest FCFL pass on their own.
- Any non-PPR pass rider must be accompanied by any PPR pass rider that you designate.

These passes are only eligible for FCFL and cannot be used for FCFEL travel.

Employees/retirees, parents, spouses/domestic partners and dependent children continue to be eligible for FCFL and Fly Confirmed for Even Less (FCFEL) travel.

2. How many FCFL guest passes do I receive?

All eligible employees and retirees will receive four FCFL guest passes each year on their hire anniversary date. The first batch was issued on Jan. 30, 2026.

On your next hire anniversary date, the passes expire and four new passes will be loaded to your account. Unused guest passes do not roll over.

3. Does a PPR passrider traveling as NRSA qualify as an accompaniment?

No. The PPR passrider(s) and their accompanying guest must be booked under the same reservation, which requires both travelers to use Fly Confirmed for Less (FCFL) tickets.

4. Do I get deducted a guest pass for any accompanying PPR pass rider?

- If the PPR member is already eligible for FCFL without using a guest slot, only the guest's ticket will count toward the employee's FCFL guest allotment.
- Secondary Companions and Nondependent children always count toward the FCFL guest allotment, meaning a guest pass is deducted each time they use an FCFL ticket.

5. How do I add and ticket a non-pass rider to the Fly Confirmed Discount program?

Go to TravelNet:

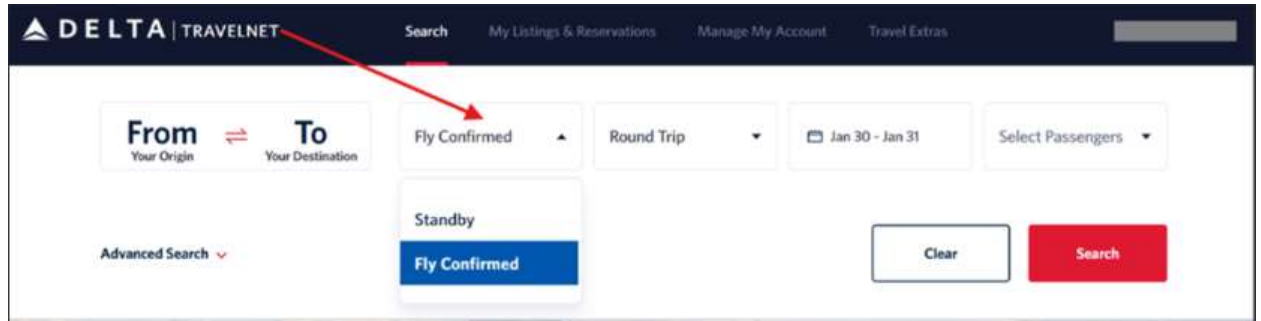
- HTML: TravelNet > Leisure Travel > Fly Confirmed Discount Programs.
- Mobile: TravelNet > Scroll down to Fly Confirmed.

Then there are two options to add non-pass riders to Fly Confirmed Discount bookings:

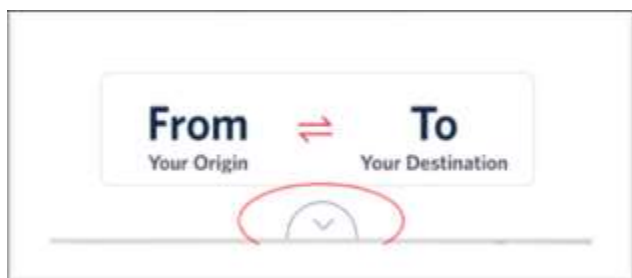
Option 1

Select Fly Confirmed from the drop down:

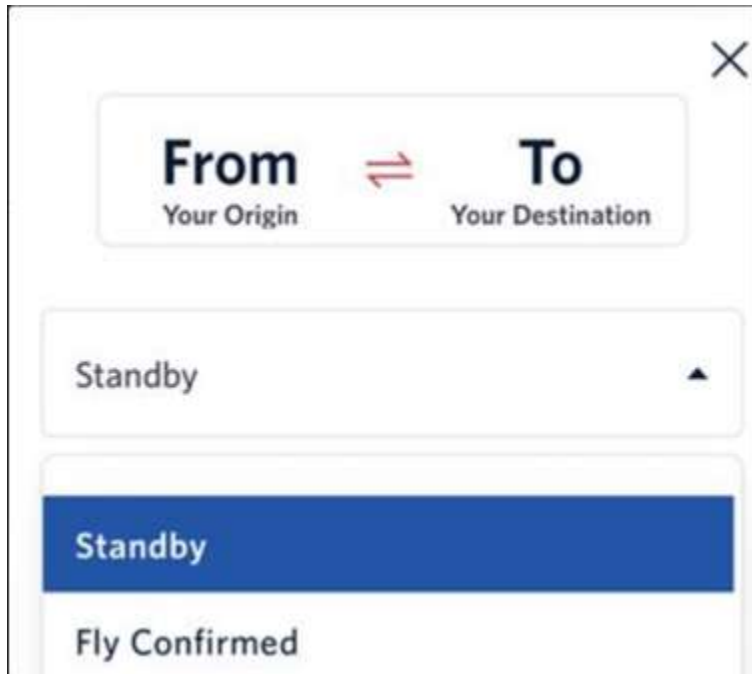
- HTML:

Mobile View

From the Search Page

- Enter your flight search criteria for Fly Confirmed and then click “Select Passengers”
- Click “Add Guest”
- You will be redirected to Manage My Account.
- Scroll to the bottom section labeled “Fly Confirmed Allotment”.
- You can select one of your PPR passriders + a guest(s) not listed in your PPR.
- Fill out required information for the guest(s) and click Save.
- Click on “Go to Search” to return to the Fly Confirmed shopping experience where you can select remaining passengers and begin your search.

Option 2

From Manage My Account

Scroll to the section “Fly Confirmed Allotment”

- You can select your secondary companion, nondependent(s) and or “ADD” guest(s) not listed in your PPR
- Fill out required information for the guest(s) and click Save
- Click on “Go to Search” to launch the Fly Confirmed shopping experience where you can select remaining passengers and begin your search

6. Which guests must be accompanied by a PPR pass rider?

Only a person you personally know who is not on your PPR pass rider list.

7. Will I be assessed any imputed income?

No, imputed income does not apply to FCFL tickets.

8. How can I apply ecredits and/or a gift card for FCFL on modern TravelNet?

9. How can I select multiple cities for FCFL on modern TravelNet?

That feature will be added in future updates to the site. In the meantime, please call Reservations for assistance.

10. Do the regular etiquette and other related pass travel rules apply to FCFL guest passes?

Yes. All rules apply. Any misuse of travel privileges – including inappropriate conduct on an aircraft, nonreviving after canceling a ticket less than 7 days prior to the travel date, using passes for business purposes, selling them, or any other violation may result in disciplinary action, up to and including termination.

11. Are there any additional restrictions?

- The Fly Confirmed discounts only apply at time of ticketing and will not be given retroactively.
- Fly Confirmed tickets are for leisure travel only.
- Flying NRSA (non-revenue standby travel) is not allowed on any Delta or Delta Connection flight on the same day, same origin city and same destination city in which a pass rider currently holds a confirmed reservation.
- Flying NRSA is also not allowed if that confirmed reservation is not cancelled more than seven days prior to the booked departure date.

- Manipulation of fare levels and/or inventory to achieve a lower fare is prohibited.
- Tickets may not be resold, transferred, or reissued to another carrier.
- Noncompliance with this policy may result in disciplinary action that could include suspension of travel privileges or termination.

12. Are there any blackout dates?

No, there are no blackout dates.

13. Can I change the name on an FCFL pass?

- **If the traveler is not ticketed yet:**

Yes. You can delete the existing authorization and submit a new authorization under the correct name.

- **If the traveler is already ticketed:**

No. Name changes are not permitted once the pass has been ticketed.

14. What if I booked a FCFL ticket and now I want to bring my friend? How do I book now that I have these passes?

You would need to cancel your original booking and rebook adding your friend. These passes cannot be combined with other existing bookings to meet accompaniment rules.

15. Why does the arrow down on the displayed fare class not always work?

If there are no other fares available besides the one that is displayed, there are no other fares to display. Clicking on the arrow will select the only available fare.
