

Professional Appearance Requirements for Flight Attendants

Our Flight Attendants are the face of Endeavor Air, as they spend the most time with our customers. They must be focused on safety, customer service, and teamwork while delivering exceptional service and creating a memorable experience for our customers.

The flight attendant uniform represents professional pride in our airline, safety, commitment to customer service, and teamwork.

To help ensure commitment to the Endeavor brand and customer service, the 'Flight Attendant Style Requirements' our flight attendants adhere to on the job should stand out during the hiring process, Initial Qualification learning program.

The following is inclusive of, but not limited to, Endeavor Air's 'Flight Attendant Style Requirements':

TATTOOS: Visible tattoos are not permitted and must be covered by clothing or waterproof make-up. Bandages, watches or jewelry are not suitable to cover tattoos at any time. Tattoos on the hands or fingers are never permitted and may not be covered with make-up or bandages due to frequent handwashing required on the job.

HAIR & NAILS: Hair color must be a natural-looking hue. No stark highlights or unnatural shades. • Hair touching or longer than the shoulder must be pulled completely back and secured away from the eyes, such as in a ponytail, bun or braid. • Nails must be clean and trimmed, no longer than ½ inch from fingertips. No neon or multi-colors, adornments, designs, glitter or chrome finish.

JEWELRY: A single side-nose piercing with a pinhead stud is permitted. No other facial or visible body piercings are allowed. • A maximum of two earrings per ear are permitted. Earrings can be studs only and should be no larger than a dime. No hoop earrings. • Ear stretching gauges are not permitted.

CLOTHING: Professional attire is always a must. Dresses and skirts should be at or below the knee in length. We will work with you to accommodate a specific manner of dress or physical appearance in keeping with religious beliefs or practices unless it causes a safety hazard or other undue burden on the company.
